Parish Rectory Question: We have six months remaining on the mortgage for the rectory on Forest Creek. We are looking at all of the reasons for maintaining two rectories. The onsite rectory, St. Joseph House, is too small for two priests but we cannot afford an associate pastor at the present time. We have begun looking into the feasibility of finishing the basement for a future assistant pastor to provide additional living space for a second priest. We will update the parish as we get more information and consider our options.


