Gospel Reflection:

In the Gospel, St. John recounts the cure of a man blind from birth. This miracle demonstrates several things. At the time, many thought illness, hardship or tragedy were the result of someone's sin, or perhaps the sin of their parents, that God was visibly punishing. What had the blind man done or what transgression has his parents performed that God punished him? Jesus assures his listeners God doesn't work that way. It's no-one's fault the man is blind. Today we still have a tendency to blame God for illness or suffering - why did God give this person cancer? Why did God take that person away - they didn't deserve to die. What is our conception of God if we think He behaves this way? That's not the Father of Jesus we see in the Gospels.
