Sunday Reflection: This Sunday of Easter is called "Good Shepherd Sunday". It is the Sunday on which our archdiocese takes up a special collection in support of men studying to the priesthood, our seminarians. Jesus is unique because he is both the Lamb of God and the Good Shepherd. We too are lambs or sheep – we are the flock of Jesus, who follow the Good Shepherd. In the Collect at the beginning of Mass we prayed: "Almighty ever-living God, lead us to a share in the joys of heaven so that the humble flock may reach where the brave shepherd has gone before." To be a disciple of Christ is to be a follower of Jesus, not someone blazing a new trail. In our personal lives, we follow and live on into the reality of where Christ went first – a life of obedience to God, a life of service to our brothers and sisters, a life that encounters and embraces the Cross, a life that then looks forward to the Resurrection from the Dead and the life of the world to come. We follow where Christ first walked.
