More than 70,000 Canadians have died by euthanasia since it was legalized. The euthanasia rate is three times the suicide rate. Why has euthanasia become such a temptation for so many Canadians? How can we create and put forward a more attractive alternative vision? Come hear Amanda Achtman share stories of travelling across the country engaging Canadians on the big questions of suffering, death, meaning, and hope.
