**Reflection:** We pray in our Mass today: “[God the Father] delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.” There are two kingdoms in the world: the kingdom of light and the kingdom of darkness. If we are united to Christ our head, then we are already a member of his kingdom and are under his authority and protection. If we choose to live in the kingdom of darkness, we are under the dominion of sin and death. We choose which kingdom we want to belong to and which king we want to honour and obey. These two kingdoms are governed by very different rules. The kingdom of light lives by mercy, peace, patience, justice, compassion, love and joy. The kingdom of darkness thrives on sin, selfishness and ugly behaviour. In which kingdom do we want to live? To which king will we give our obedience?


