Gospel Reflection: The secular thanksgiving holiday we celebrate this weekend only makes sense if we think for a moment to whom are we offering thanksgiving? How can you celebrate thanksgiving without thanking God? The word Eucharist is a Greek word which means "thanksgiving." Every celebration of the Mass is an act of thanksgiving to God for his goodness and many blessings. Sometimes people explain they don't go to church because they don't get anything out of it but that is getting things backward. We don't go to church to get something, we go to give something - our gratitude to God which we express in the practice of our faith. Then, God who has already given us so much, when we return to thank him for his generosity, gives us in the holy Eucharist the supreme gift of Jesus Christ, truly present in holy communion - body, blood, soul and divinity.
