Gospel Reflection: In the Gospel parable today, both the Pharisee and the tax collector reference themselves in their prayer to God. The first uses his prayer not only to congratulate himself on his righteous behaviour, but also to compare himself to his neighbour at his neighbour's expense. The tax collector, on the other hand, focuses only on his own sinfulness and begs God's mercy. The tax collector's prayer was ruthlessly honest with himself and God. His humility and self-awareness are models for us and our relationship with the Lord.

Pray for Persecuted Christians Across the World: I was asked recently if we could pray for the persecuted Christians in Nigeria. We regularly pray during the week for persecuted Christians across the globe. The media rarely report widespread persecution of Christians. It is a good reminder to specifically address the fact that Christianity is the most persecuted faith right now in the world. I have mentioned this a number of times in the weekend homilies, but for the latest statistics, go to the website www.opendoors.org to see the most recent numbers: 380 million Christians faced persecution last year; 1 in 5 Christians in Africa and 2 in 5 in Asia are persecuted. Last year, 4,476 Christians were killed for reasons related to our faith. Fifty countries are on a watch list for their active harassment and persecution of our sisters and brothers in Christ. The media in the West are largely silent. It is good to remember that we need to pray for our sisters and brothers wherever they are facing discrimination, persecution, oppression, violence, theft and even death for our faith. Fr. Geoff

Respect Life Ministry invitation: Join us for **40 Days for Life**, a peaceful campaign of silent prayer, fasting, and public vigil for an end to abortion running from Sep 24 to Nov 2. Our parish will cover vigil hour **Sun, Oct 26 (2-3 pm) at the southwest corner of Queen Street just off Bank Street**. Former abortion industry workers say it was the prayer presence outside their facilities that turned them away from abortion, and drop-off rates at clinics can reach as high as 75% when there's a prayer vigil nearby. Come stand with us in prayer; contact the parish office or simply meet us at the vigil location.

Horizons of Hope: A Faith-Based Approach to Palliative Care Join us for *Horizons of Hope*, a two-day program designed to help Catholics explore palliative care, illness, dying, and end-of-life decisions through the lens of faith. This national initiative from the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops offers guidance, prayer, and discussion to support those accompanying loved ones through serious illness. 
