Join us for 40 Days for Life, a peaceful campaign of silent prayer, fasting, and public vigil for an end to abortion running from Sep 24 to Nov 2. Our parish will cover vigil hours Sat, Sep 27 (2-3 pm) and Sun, Oct 26 (2-3 pm) at the southwest corner of Queen Street just off Bank Street. Former abortion industry workers say it was the prayer presence outside their facilities that turned them away from abortion, and drop-off rates at clinics can reach as high as 75% when there's a prayer vigil nearby.
