CONFIRMATION 2026

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated at Christ the King on **Tuesday, May 26, 2026 at 7:00 pm.**

Students who are in Grade 7 are eligible to receive this sacrament. Older students and young adults who may have missed an earlier reception of this Sacrament are welcome to participate at this time. Baptismal Certificates are required for all candidates.

Attendance at each of the four (4) preparation sessions is mandatory. Parents are expected to accompany their son / daughter to **Sessions 1 and 2 only.** All sessions will be held in the Small Hall.

Reflection: The readings of today beautifully connect with Divine Mercy Sunday, celebrating God's boundless mercy revealed through Jesus. On John's Gospel, Jesus appears to His disciples, offering them peace despite their fear and doubt. When He shows His wounds to Thomas, as He appears to them a second time, it's a powerful reminder of His love and mercy, especially for those who struggle to believe. Jesus' words, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe," invite us to trust in His merciful presence even when we cannot see it. In Acts, the early Christians lived out this mercy by caring deeply for one another, sharing their possessions so that "there was no needy person among them." Their unity and selflessness show how mercy transforms communities. Divine Mercy Sunday calls us to receive God's forgiveness and extend it to others. As we experience God's mercy, we're called to be like the early Christians, building a world of sharing, compassion, peace and unity through our faith and acts of love.
