JUST A REMINDER... There will be no 12:05 pm Masses at Christ the King on Tuesday, April 22, and Wednesday, April 23. The regular Mass schedule will resume on Thursday, April 24. At this Mass we will welcome Marymount Academy students.

PRE-AUTHORIZED DONATION PROGRAM... Christ the King has made it easier for parishioners to make contributions to the parish through the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie PADP program. When you participate in PADP your bank account will be debited your predetermined donation automatically once a month. This amount will be credited to your parish's account and at year's end; the parish will issue you a charitable receipt for your donations. You can participate in this program by completing the required form and including a cheque marked VOID with it to the parish office. These forms can be obtained from the office and from the pamphlet racks at the entrances to the church. You can change the amount of your donation or withdraw from this program at any time.

FIRST COMMUNION... will be **May 25** at the **11:00 a.m.** Mass at the Church of Christ the King. We would like to remind all parents and children who are preparing for First Communion that meetings will be May 1, 8, 15 and 22 at 6:30 p.m. in the large hall. We look forward to working with you again.

CANONIZATION OF BLESSED JOHN PAUL II AND BLESSED JOHN XXIII ... On April 27, 2014, Pope Francis will declare his two predecessors Saints. Recognizing that Blessed John XXIII and John Paul II have widespread reputations for holiness and that after years of studying their lives and actions have proven their exceptional virtue. Both Popes were also responsible for great political and cultural transformation. Blessed John Paul II served as Pope from 1978 to 2005 and was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI on Divine Mercy Sunday, May 1, 2011. He is known as one of the most influential leaders of the 20th century. Blessed John XXIII, known particularly for convoking the Second Vatican Council, was Pope from 1958 to 1963; Blessed John Paul II beatified him in 2000.

Msgr. Farrell was a retired priest in our Diocese who died on April 10, 2014. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1954 and retired in 2001. Msgr. Farrell was pastor of our parish of Christ the King from 1981-87. His contribution to the life of our Diocese was exceptional. Please remember Msgr. Farrell and his family in your prayers.

SAINTS' CORNER

BLESSED MARIE-ANNE BLONDIN... Sister Marie-Anne was born in what is now a suburb of Montreal in 1809. She learned how to read and write while working as a domestic for nuns. By 1850, with the permission of Bishop Bourget, she founded the Congregation of the Sisters of Saint Anne for educating poor boys and girls in non-segregated classrooms. Because of that approach, considered "subversive" at the time by the local clergy, she endured much suffering and sorrow.
