Welcome to the newest member of our Christian community! Pray that this child may be constantly renewed by the life of the Spirit that dwells within her.

**Reflection:** Jesus presents himself as the door of the sheepfold. The shepherd ensures that all the sheep come into the sheepfold. Once the shepherd has brought in all the sheep to the sheepfold, he remains at the door or even lies down at the door in the night. Thus, he watches over the sheep in the night. This presence of the shepherd who acts as the door prevents the sheep from going out of the fold. It also protects the sheep from the attack of thieves and wild animals. When Jesus uses this imagery, he assures us of his protection under his watchful care. We can rest secure within his fold. That is why the Psalmist could say *"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me"* (PS23:4)
