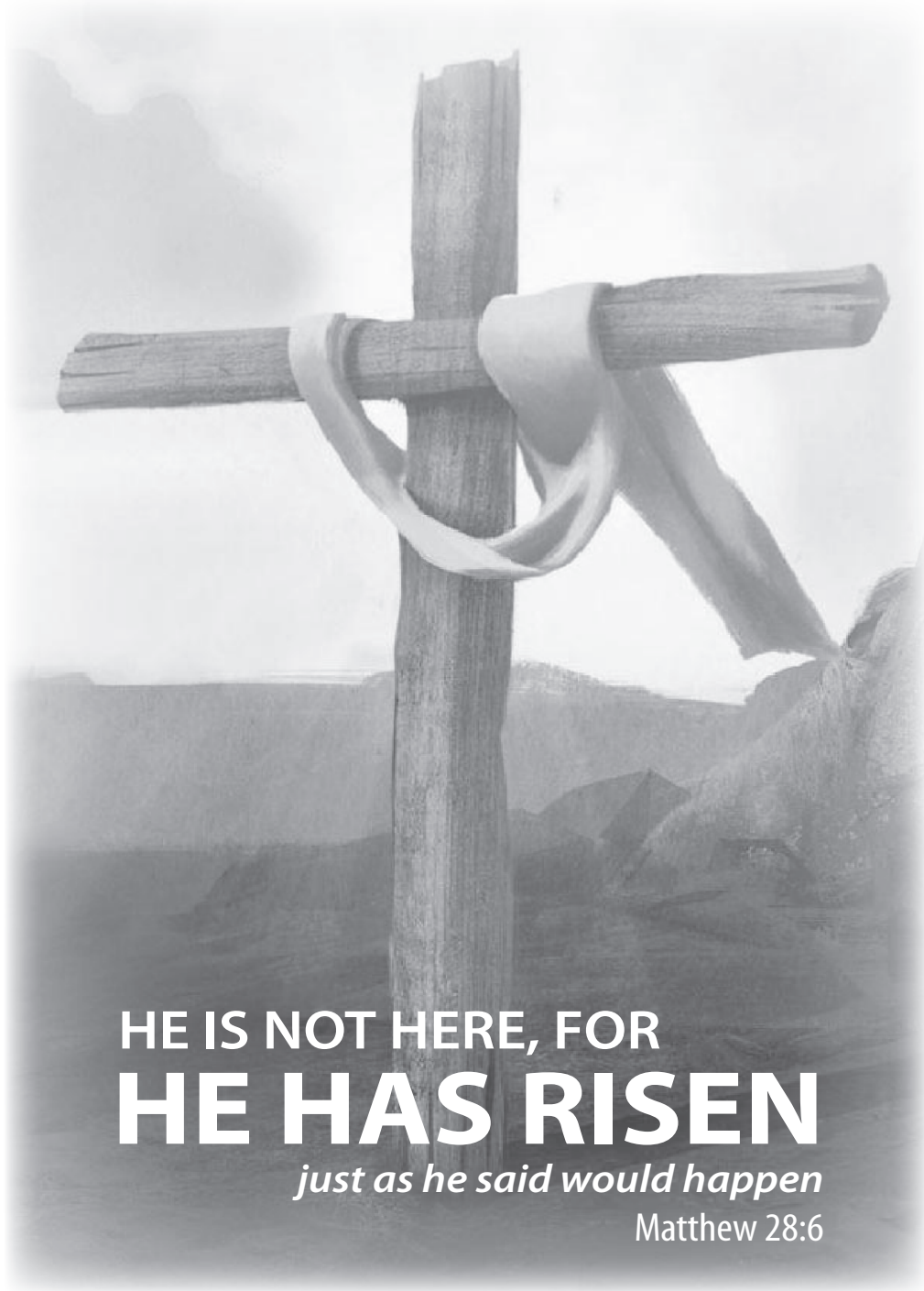

Reflection: *"The grave is the place where no one who enter ever leaves. But Jesus emerged for us; He rose for us, to bring life where there was death, to begin a new story in the very place where a stone has been placed. He, who rolled away the stone that sealed the entrance of the tomb, can also remove the stones in our hearts. So, let us not give in to resignation; let us not place a stone before hope.*

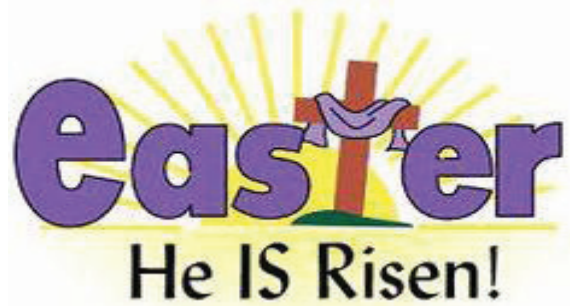

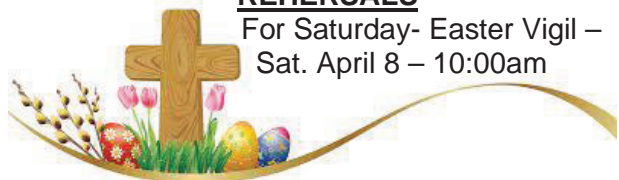
