SAINTS' CORNER

Blessed Frederic Janssoone ... born in 1838 in Flanders to a farming family. In 1856, Frederic left school to support his widowed mother and after his mother died he completed his studies and joined the Franciscans. He was sent to the Holy Land and in 1881, came to Canada on a fundraising mission and by 1888 was permanently staying in Canada. Frederic helped in the establishment of the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary at Cap-de-Madeleine. He died on August 4, 1916 in Montreal, is buried in the crypt of the Franciscan chapel at Trios-Rivieres and was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1988.
