Similarly, temptation often strikes at the core of our identity, making us doubt our worth, purpose, or calling. Lent is an opportune time to return to the truth of who we are in God – His children. When we are secure in our identity in God, we

are less vulnerable to the lies and distortions that temptation brings. In every temptation, Jesus responds with scripture. This shows us the importance of being grounded in God's Word as a way to resist temptation. The period of Lent invites us to spend time in Scripture-reading and prayer, allowing God's Word to strengthen us in moments of trial.
