**Reflection:** Christian spirituality has been built along parallel lines of active and contemplative states of life. Sometimes, we allow ourselves to be drawn into unnecessary comparisons of whether it is better to be active or contemplative. As far as our life and faith is concerned, however, whether we are active or contemplative is not really the issue. What is key is whether we are living our chosen state of life well. While a contemplative life is most admirable, because of its ability to provide deep spiritual engagement with God, the active life, if properly channelled can equally enrich our sense of the Divine. *'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2025'.*
