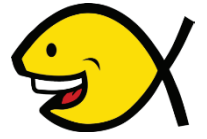
► A bilingual mass will be held at the Grotto on July 1st, 2016. The rosary will be at 6:30 followed by the mass at 7 p.m. All are invited.
