Reflection: The context of the second reading is difficult period of famine in



Jerusalem, with the Apostle Paul exhorting the Christians of Corinth to contribute to support the Church in Jerusalem. The question is, why should they? They are not obliged, but by following the example of Jesus' gracious act of choosing to die on the Cross to save mankind, they too are participating in the wellbeing of fellow Christians. This act is not forced, but one coming from free will, as well the first reading suggests. The gospel follows this same trend, with Jesus healing the woman with the haemorrhage and raising to life the daughter of the synagogue official. It is not the intention of God for His children to suffer in any way. It is due to the fall of man that these factors entered the world. God can, however, heal us and raise us up from the dead, if we believe in Him, like the woman and the synagogue official.
