Reflection: In the Gospel, we witness a powerful transformation as a man born blind encounters the ‘Light of the World’. This event illustrates two contrasting movements: the upward journey of faith and trust of the healed man, and the downward decent into scepticism and unbelief of those who resist the truth. The journey toward the Light brings blessing while the refusal to see, leads to darkness. The blind man gradually recognises Jesus as the Son of God, culminating in his act of worship. Meanwhile, those entrenched in their prejudices remain hostile, blinded by their misconceptions. We are challenged today to reflect on the direction of our spiritual life: Are we embracing the light that leads to deeper faith, or are we retreating into darkness? Let us choose the path of illumination and transformation. *‘God’s Word, Daily Reflections 2026’*
