Reflection: After Jesus had been baptised, He learned His deepest identity and mission. Now He confronts (as we too must) the great temptations. The Gospel tells us how Jesus fought off temptations by the devil and continued pursuing the important mission for the kingdom of God. First, the tempter urged Him to use His divine power to satisfy His bodily desires, which Jesus dismisses with a word. Having failed at his first attempt, the devil shifts to perhaps the greatest of the temptations: power. Power is extremely seductive. Many would gladly eschew material things, attention, or fame in order to get it. Jesus' great answer in Matthew's account of this story is "Get away, Satan!" To seek power is to serve Satan. Finally, the devil plays a subtler game: he tempts Jesus to manipulate His Father, encouraging Him to jump from the top of the Temple and let the angles save Him. It is like the temptation faced by Adam and Eve in the garden of Eden: deciding how and when God will act.


