Good Friday Pontifical Collection for the benefit of the Holy Land: Our parish, once a year on Good Friday, is called to support Christians in the Holy Land. For many Christians in the Holy Land, their lives depend on this collection.

Irish Soda Oat Bread Recipe:

In Large bowl mix:

- 1 c. of rolled oats
- ¼ c. molasses
- 2 c. of buttermilk

Mix well

In another bowl mix

- 3 c. of whole wheat flour
- 1 c. of all-purpose flour
- 1 ½ tsp soda
- ½ tsp salt
- 1 tsp of cream of tarter

Mix well.

Mix together into the large bowl. If a little dry add ¼ c. of water. Work into 2 balls and kneed into 2 round loafs. Wrap in plastic, let stand at room temperature overnight. Bake in pre-heated oven @ 400 F for 15 minutes, then @ 350F for 20 minutes. Let cool on rack. Enjoy ☺
