Reflection: Today the church celebrates Good Shepherd Sunday, also known as Vocation Sunday and is marked as World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The purpose of this day is to fulfil Our Lord's instruction to "Pray to the Lord of harvest to send labourers into His harvest" (Matthew 9:38). However, on this day, we are called to reflect on the life of Christ, the Good Shepherd. Several times in the scriptures, and particularly in John's Gospel, our Lord has referred to himself as the Good Shepherd. For example, in chapter 10 of the Gospel of John, Jesus describes Himself as a shepherd using a sheepfold in which various flocks are gathered together for the night under the vigilance of one caretaker, and the shepherd knows and calls his own sheep and leads them out to the pastures at dawn (Cf. Jn.10:1ff). In Our Lord's reference to Himself as the Good Shepherd, He shows an intimate relationship with the sheep: "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me (Jn 10:27-30). This is against our style of shepherding or leadership, where we find it difficult to identify with our followers. The only time we are close to them is when we are seeking their favour. Nevertheless, with Christ the Good Shepherd, we can align ourselves in order to achieve good leadership and lead our sheep to greener pastures. In the spirit of emulating Christ the Good Shepherd, we must be altruistic, sacrifice for our sheep, and respect their freedom. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2025'.
