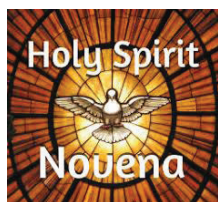

Reflection: Today, we celebrate the transformative power of the Holy Spirit and the birth of the



Church. The First Reading recounts how the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples, uniting people of diverse languages through the gift of tongues – a profound symbol of the Church's universal mission. The Psalm exalts God's creative Spirit, who renews the earth and grants life to all. In his epistle, St. Paul underscores the Spirit's role in uniting believers as one body, each endowed with unique gifts for the common good. The Sequence fervently invokes the Spirit's guidance, light and consolation. In the Gospel, Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit upon His disciples, empowering them to forgive sins and to continue His divine mission. As we reflect on this sacred occasion, we are called to embrace the gifts of the Spirit, to live in unity, and to bear bold witness to Christ's love. Trusting in the Spirit's power, we open our hearts to renewal and transformation, that we may faithfully fulfil our mission as disciples of Christ.
