Reflection:



In our first reading, St. Luke reveals how the early Church was faced with internal conflict, over the issue of circumcision. The emergence of the issue indicates why Our Lord promised the coming of the Holy Spirit in the Gospel passage, namely to direct the apostles to the Church (cf. Jn 14:25). The counsellor, the Holy Spirit, therefore, will not only come to remind the apostles of all that He, Jesus, taught them, but will also give them wisdom to judge certain matters. The conflicts the Church has encountered, and still the Church's problems have had a significant impact on its doctrine, spirituality, morality, and structure. Again, in the midst of these conflicts, the Church has always remained focused and had recourse to the Holy Spirit, who has given direction to the Church over the years. When we have problems in our homes, the domestic churches, instead of giving up, we should call on the Holy Spirit for direction and discernment.
