that we would be close to you by being close to the vulnerable and marginalized.


Give us patience to share one another's burdens, and give us the courage to always be friends of the truth. We remain with you always. Amen.

She was then blessed with a great miracle: her food never ran out until the rains fell again! God's awesome blessings may not always be tangible. Sometimes, they are rather spiritual rewards. This is a lesson from today's gospel reading. The poor widow offered all that she had to live on! Then, she was rewarded beyond her imagination.
