Reflection: Today is the beginning of a new liturgical calendar of the Church. What do you expect at the beginning? And what is God expecting of you? In a way, the Advent season reviews the old and previews the new. While night and darkness recedes, day and brightness proceeds. The purple colour of the season reminds you that our visitor is the King of kings. The season invites you to pass through the liturgical cycle, not as a routine, but to allow the Word of God to take root in you. From today onwards, you may resolve to be alert for the "comings" of the Lord: at Christmas, at the point of your death, and at the second/final visitation of our Lord in glory. This recurring question articulated in the popular song: "Would you be ready when the Lord shall come?" 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2025'

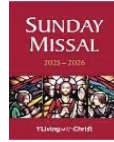

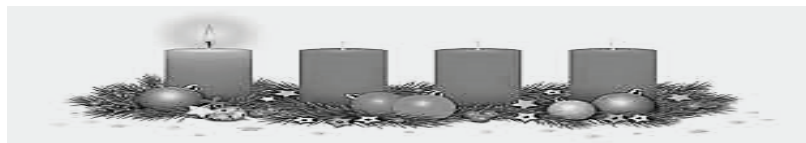
