CANADIAN ARMED FORCES DISPLAY UPDATE

100 years ago, on November 11th, WWI ended. We were a country of under 8 million. Canada had 620,000 soldiers including those from Newfoundland who were not yet part of Canada. Of those 66,000 died in service and an additional 173,000 were wounded. In many ways the commitment to peace that is such a deep part of Canada's national identity was born out of that war and the honest understanding of the price that sometimes must be paid for justice and freedom. Our Canadian Armed Forces display has been updated with an additional picture. Please pray for Master Corporal Kevin Ouellette who is currently serving in the Canadian Army in British Columbia. He has been in the Canadian Armed Forces since 1995. Kevin is the son of Gerry (deceased) and Linda Ouellette of our parish. We express our appreciation to those military currently serving and to the veterans who have proudly served our country. We will never forget.

Christ the King will be participating in the **Bells of Peace** initiative of the Canadian Legion to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the end of World War I. On Remembrance Day, **Sunday, November 11th** at sunset (4:55pm) our church bells will join others throughout the city and across Canada to ring 100 times at 5 second intervals. On November 11th, 1918 the ringing of church bells erupted spontaneously across the country as an outpouring of relief that four years of war had come to an end. The Bells of Peace initiative is designed to emulate that moment of remembrance in honour of our veterans who served in World War I.
