Ten lepers were cured, but only one came back to thank Jesus. How often do we take the time to truly thank God for all of the wonderful things that He has given to us?

Pray with our children for the grace to appreciate God's many gifts for each of us and to remember to say thank you for these, always.

**Reflection:** The Gospel of today has many interrelated dimensions: of healing, of gratitude (or lack of it) and of the Samaritan, who is a foreigner. We are told of ten lepers who asked Jesus for 'mercy'; they were asking Him to cure them of the disease which had made them outcasts in their society. Realizing their suffering, Jesus heals them instructing them "go show yourselves to the priests." They did so with diligence; delighted with their healing they completely forget

who has cured them. All of them but one who is a Samaritan, a "foreigner', go away, the Samaritan coming back to thank Jesus, falling at His feet and praising God. Jesus is prompted to ask 'Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine?' We need to introspect on the way we often treat 'others': those who are not like us, the strangers in our midst.
