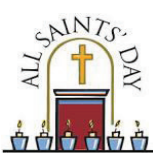

Everyone is welcome to this blessed celebration

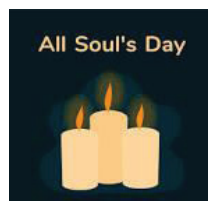
ALL SOULS DAY
