Jesus tells us that God wants us to be humble. Humility begins with knowledge of our weaknesses and limitations and being honest about our abilities.

Pray with our children for the grace to live humbly.

Reflection: The parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector is about two persons, with two different styles of prayer, one who personifies pride and the other who epitomizes humility. The Pharisee is clear about his so called 'holiness'; he is self-righteous about it and he boastfully tells God that he is not a sinner like the tax collector and that he faithfully observes all the ritualistic practices and other prescriptions. The tax collector, on the other hand, is humble, acknowledges that he is a sinner and seeks God's mercy. The Pharisee does not feel the need of God, he thinks that he is self-sufficient, thanks to his holier-than-thou attitude. On the other hand, the humble tax collector, who stands at a distance, genuinely seeks the face of God. In our prayer, in our attitudes and actions: are we like the Pharisee or the tax collector?

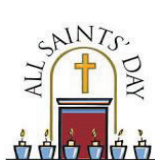

Everyone is welcome to this blessed celebration

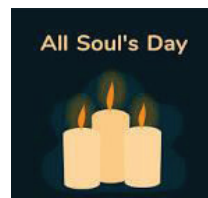
ALL SOULS DAY
