Jesus healed Bartimaeus, the blind man. After he was healed, Bartimaeus became one of Jesus' followers.
Pray with our children in gratitude for the gift of sight to see the world of beauty that the Lord offers us.

Reflection: In the Gospel of today, we have the story of the cure of Bartimaeus. Bartimaeus didn't allow the crowd to discourage him from reaching Jesus. He didn't stop calling on the Lord for help. He is a good example of persistent faith that refuses to be discouraged. However, today, let us shift our attention to Jesus. Even though there is a crowd and there is noise and commotion, He notices Bartimaeus; He hears his cry for help. In the Second Reading of today, the author of the Letter to the Hebrews tells us that Jesus is a compassionate High Priest who deals gently with those in need. The first reading also tells us that the Father and the Son are one in compassion and generous love. They do not neglect the cry of those in distress. This is an encouragement to us that God takes notice of our cries and pains. It is also a call to us to imitate our Lord and God in being attentive to the cries of those in need and stop and help, just as we ourselves have been helped by God. 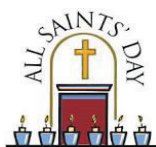

ROSARY PROCESSION WITH MARY

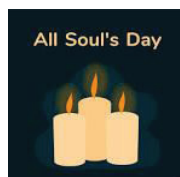
October 27th at 3:30pm we will be praying the rosary as we process near the church with the statue of our Blessed Mother.

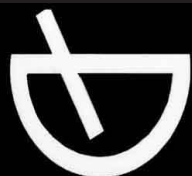
