Sudbury Right to Life invites everyone to our Annual Life Chain, taking place this Sunday, October the fifth. We will gather at the corners of Paris Street and Centennial Drive, down from Health Sciences North between the hours of 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm to prayerfully and silently witness for the unborn. Reflection: The core of today's Gospel passage is faith. We are all invited to join the apostles as they plead with Jesus, "Lord, increase our faith." That leaves us with the question: what is 'faith'? Too often we associate faith with saying prayers and preforming ritualistic practices; whilst all of that many have their specific roles, faith is much more. The apostles in today's Gospel passage are unsure of their faith; with deep sincerity, they are convinced they need much more of it. They are not afraid to approach Jesus with their doubt. Jesus' response is that if one's faith is genuine, however little it may seem (even like a grain of mustard), one could do incredible things. Faith is tangible and is manifested in our attitudes and actions. The one prayer that should always be on our lips and in our hearts is "Lord, increase my faith...help my unbelief".
