Reflection:



The crucifixion of Jesus on the Cross was extremely shameful; it exposed his almost naked and pierced body to derision from his enemies. However, this shameful lifting up of Jesus was used by God to save us all. Looking at the bronze serpent saved the people of Israel from physical death, but looking up to Christ saves us from eternal death. The uplifted serpent was the only cure in the camp, just as Jesus Christ is the only Saviour for Sinners. Nobody could look at the bronze serpent for another person; each dying person had to look at himself or herself. The salvation Christ offers is personal and individual, and each of us must look to Christ by faith. The only salvation available was what God had graciously provided the only begotten Son who was pierced for our salvation on the Cross. The promise of salvation and deliverance is free, and anyone who looks at Jesus on the will be healed, saved and delivered from eternal death.
