When the report of abuse of his position reached his master's ear, he was asked to draw up an account of his stewardship. The allegation was wastage, abuse or stealing. This is the same word used for the prodigal son in Greek – 'diaskorpizo' meaning wasteful, wastage, abuse'. Am I wasting the privilege of my position? The dishonest steward called for 'all his master's debtors and tactfully reduced their debts, so that they would accept him in their homes, when he was forced to quit.
