Reflection: Today's Gospel speaks about the need for fraternal correction. If I am sore about somebody, then the first person for me to approach is that person, with respect and kindness, whether it is a relation or acquaintance. The goal is not so much to put the offender on trial, but to persuade the offender to see the wrong and to be reconciled. And if this fails, then we must still not give up, but seek the help of the Christian Community. The presence of Jesus in the community is highlighted in these Gospel words, "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them." In caring and challenging the offending member, in gathering together in the Lord's name, he has a chance to realise his mistake. In many ways, we are keepers of our sisters and brothers. We have social responsibility in the family and in the neighbourhood. Let us see Jesus in each person we meet, and pray for the offender – for healing and reconciliation.
