# **Reflection:**



Jesus Christ makes a distinction between discipleship and salvation, but above all, He connected salvation and the Cross as one and the same. He was on the way to Jerusalem; this final journey would end with His supreme act of love in offering Himself as a Lamb to be sacrificed on the altar of the Cross. Salvation definitely means coming to the Cross and trusting Jesus Christ, while discipleship means carrying the Cross and following

Jesus Christ. To bear the Cross means daily identification and walking with Christ in shame, suffering and surrender to the will of God. Jesus Christ carried His Cross to Calvary and won victory for us in His resurrection. We cannot have Christianity on our terms, but on the terms of Jesus Christ. Christianity is a Cross-bearing enterprise, not a miracle -chasing enterprise.
