Jesus appears to the frightened disciples, and in the midst of their fears and confusion, breathes on them the Holy Spirit and gives them the gift of His Mercy.

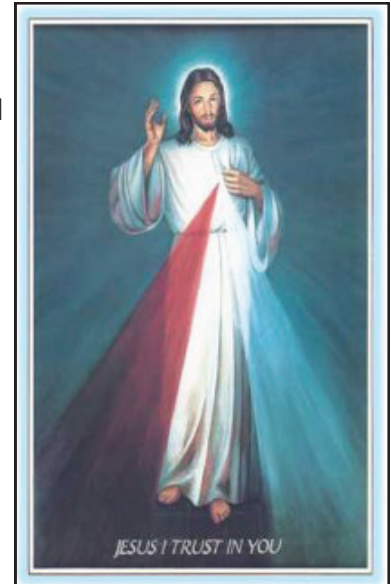
Thomas journeys from doubt to faith and proclaims, "My Lord and My God" in the midst of his brothers.
