## *April 2, 2023 - Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord*

My sisters and brothers in Christ,

We begin the solemn observation of Holy Week today. Today we commemorate the triumphal entry of Christ into His city Jerusalem.

Crowds which followed Jesus into the city from the countryside threw palms under the colt's feet to ease the passage of the Saviour into the city. Hopefully, during this season of Lent, we have spread more than palms before the Lord.
