In today's reading we can see two scenes: Jesus' appearance to his disciples after his resurrection and Jesus' dialogue with Thomas, the doubting disciple. Jesus greets his disciples with the gift of peace and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus also commissions his disciples to continue the work that has begun. It's very important to recognize that as Jesus was sent by God, so too does Jesus send his disciples, and send to us to announce peace and love to our neighbor. Don't worry about the means because Jesus gives us the means to accomplish this mission.

Even when we have some doubts in our lives, we can feel unto ourselves, the effect of Jesus' resurrection as love, peace, and forgiveness. In today's Gospel, Jesus' words to his disciples highlight the integral connection between the forgiveness and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Forgiveness and reconciliation are the gifts to us from Jesus. We can share these with others with the grace of the Holy Spirit.

Today's bulletin is titled "Bumps, Bruises, and Blessing" which is impelling us to learn and grow in our ability to love, to serve, to welcome others, to communicate, to be faithful, and to be who we are called to be, disciples of Jesus. It is an apprenticeship of discipleship. *Fr. Mario*
