20th Sunday in Ordinary Time — August 20, 2023: Perseverance

We need to persevere in prayer. Jesus is not being insulting to the Canaanite woman, he is drawing faith out of her. She has the depth to reply, "Even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their masters' tables." "Woman great is your faith!"

Again, we are given another example in sacred scripture that it is often the foreigner, the "outsider" who penetrates the mystery and invitation of who Jesus is. Jesus calls us to go deep to put out into the deep. Our prayer is to be daily, hourly, moment by moment. Jesus is not calling this woman a dog but we all have a master. She was not of the people of Israel, and Jesus had a preferential option for them, "the lost sheep of the house of Israel" but he did not limit his attention to them. His "sitio", his thirst is for love. He thirsted for the Canaanites' love, so he longs for ours.

She petitions for her daughter's liberation; she perseveres in her cry. She kneels before Jesus. She responds to Jesus. Her faith is rewarded.

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time — August 27, 2023: "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"

Jesus asks his disciples what people are talking about. There are various opinions: John the Baptist comes back from the dead, Elijah returning from his flaming chariot ride, Jeremiah, one of the prophets. Various opinions.

Jesus then turns to them and to us, "Who do you say that I am?" Inspired by the Holy Spirit, Peter gets it right, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." "Now Peter, you have told me who I am, let me tell you who you are. "You are Peter (Cephas – the rock) and on this rock I will build my Church." Hell shall not prevail against her. Peter at the institution of the Petrine ministry is given the "keys" to the Kingdom of God – loosing and binding. Jesus didn't give Peter the keys to the city of Jerusalem like we give a symbolic key to the city to a celebrity, leader, etc. In the days of the Old Testament, the Prime Minister, the one who represents the King, would literally wear the "Key" to the city on his shoulder – they were big! So, when people saw him, they knew that he ruled in the absence of the King. Jesus will leave His Church on earth to the ministry of Peter and his successors.

Now Jesus can ask of us, "who do you say that I am?" Is our credal confession on Sunday the same profession our actions and decisions make? We all struggle with this. Only by God's grace can we live out daily what our lips profess on Sunday.

I will be in Quebec on our parish Shrines of Quebec pilgrimage and will return on Saturday August 26th.
