## *February 5, 2023 - 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time*

Salt and Light; two very common things that we encounter every day. Salt adds flavor and also has a preservative quality to it and light we need daily just to live our days, we need light to navigate the pathways of life.

Jesus asks his followers to be salt and light. Salt in the ancient world was a highly prized commodity. In arid and desert climates, salt was able to preserve meat and other necessary staples - it was also a form of currency - Roman soldiers were known to be paid in salt.

So, Jesus is reminding us that as followers of Christ, as children of the Father, we have great worth. That the Children of Light have a special role in the world - to be agents of preservation - to witness to the redeeming effects of the Gospel.

So, salt losing its qualities makes it useless, light that is hidden is useless. We cannot "hide" our light, live our lives as Christians privately - under the bushel basket of safety.

We need to be SALT AND LIGHT FOR THE WORLD - for others. The "salt" of the Gospel, its power to preserve and heal from sin must be made known. The "light" of witness to the risen Lord is often proclaimed by our deeds more than our words.

Next weekend we will celebrate the World Day of Prayer for the Sick with the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick after the weekend Masses at all of our parishes.

#### **World Day of Prayer for the Sick**

On February 11th and 12th, we will observe the World Day of Prayer for the Sick. We will be offering, after all of the weekend Masses, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for those who are ill. To receive the sacrament, you must be either: preparing for surgery, recovering from surgery, have a serious procedure pending, have a chronic or debilitating condition (i.e. cancer, diabetes, etc.) or be suffering from psychological issues. This is not a blessing, it is a Sacrament of the Church - a personal encounter with the Risen Lord. So, I ask that you only come forward if you are described above.
