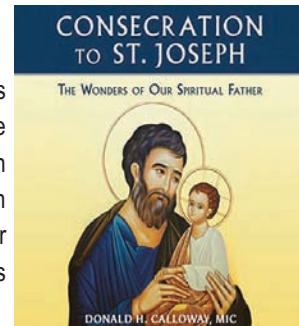

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Peter shows us his act of faith in this passage as a great model for the trust that we as Christians are called to deposit in Jesus. He is tired after a day of unproductive labor. However, when Jesus tells him to try just one more time, he obeys, and the recompense for his trust is overwhelming.

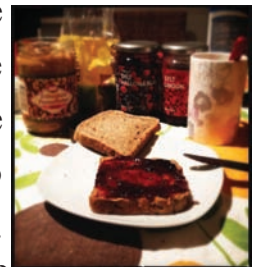
How often do we forget to trust in Christ with every fiber of our being? Sometimes, we fall two or three times, and it seems like giving up would be so much easier, especially in this uncertainty time when it is difficult to try again and again. But we are called to hold strong, to double down in the face of adversity and desolation, and to put even more faith in Christ. As St. Ignatius said, we must not give in to periods of desolation in our spiritual lives and our daily journey. When it seems we are alone, we must push just a bit further to find our consolation in Christ. Probably our consolation will be consisting in to hear the voice of Jesus "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." And also he will said "do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people."

Like Simon, we need the help of our Friends to accomplish the mission before us. The Word of God calls us into relationship with him and with another.

How has the Word and the efforts of your community helped you? In times of risk or danger? When has the Word and your neighbor called you to mission? Do you share the abundance of God's grace ad mercy with your Friends and neighbors? *Fr. Mario*
