PASTOR'S PEN

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD - CANDLEMAS SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2025

Since this feast is usually celebrated during the week, now we get a rare chance for all to celebrate it this year. February 2nd marks the 40th day since the birth or Nativity of the Lord. According to the Mosaic law, every first-born male child had to be offered to the Lord in the temple. This was traditionally the feast which ended the season of Christmas. We have a rather truncated Christmas season now.

The main theme of this feast is Light. Christ, the Light of the World, comes to the temple. From Malachi, Chapter 3, we read, "See, I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me, and the Lord whom you seek will suddenly come to his temple. The messenger of the covenant in whom you delight - indeed, He is coming, says the Lord of hosts. But who can endure the day of his coming, and who can stand when he appears?"

Christ comes as an infant of purity (the beeswax symbolizing purity) to His Father's house. Who will recognize His coming? The faithful "anawim" of God's people personified in the person of the priest and prophet Simeon. In his old age he represents the ancient covenant soon to be perfected in the new. Simeon promised by the Lord that he would not taste death until he was shown the Christ, the messiah, breaks out into a canticle of praise, the "Nunc Dimittis" at the sight of the Christ Child.

Now dismiss Thy servant, O Lord,
in peace, according to Thy word:
For mine own eyes hath seen
Thy salvation, Which Thou hast prepared
in the sight of all the peoples,
A light to reveal Thee to the nations
and the glory of Thy people Israel. - Luke 2:29

My own eyes have seen thy salvation, Simeon held, Simeon beheld with his very eyes the Christ his people longed for....and so have we! In the most intimate of communions, Christ comes to us and reveals himself as the Light of the World in the Bread of Life! We bless candles on this day commemorating his "epiphany" to Simeon and the Children of Israel, the entrance of the eternal light in the fulfillment of the Mosaic law. "Suddenly (He) will come to his temple." Simeon was ready, Simeon recognized this infant amongst possibly dozens that day because he longed for His coming and God is faithful to His promises.

Let us pray this Candlemas weekend that we too may long for a fuller coming of the Christ and His Light into our sometimes-dark world and lives. This light of revelation, this glory of the people of Isreal, and the New Isreal the Body of Christ.

Happy Candlemas!!!
