## January 15, 2023 - 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Wedding Feast of Cana

We begin this short span of Ordinary time (just over a month until Lent) with the third of the "epiphanies" we celebrate during the Christmas Season. The first is the revelation of the Christ Child to the nations through the three Kings or Wisemen. The second is the revelation of the Father and Spirit at the Baptism of the Lord - the showing forth of divine love and mandate of Christ's public ministry. And finally, the third is today's event at Cana of Galilee - the first of the seven signs found in the Gospel of John.

Today the "old" wine of the old testament is brought to perfection in the "new" wine of the new and definitive testament. Through the intercession of Mary, a need is pointed out to the Lord. An ordinary but necessary element of life - water, is then transformed into the extraordinary wine of Christ. The natural coming together of man and woman is elevated to that of a sacrament, foreshadowing the marriage of Christ and His Church. Jesus rejoices in the love of our "nameless" couple - as he rejoices in the events that bring joy to our lives.

Speaking of joy, I have a wonderful announcement to make: our new Spanish speaking priest, Fr. Paul Okoth Auma, Consolata Missionary, currently in Colombia, will be arriving in London on Tuesday, January 17th. We welcome you warmly Fr. Paul and pray that your ministry among us will be blessed! For the first six months of Fr. Paul's stay, he will be undergoing a process of enculturation - learning our customs, ways, and getting drivers ED, etc. He will be celebrating the Mass and sacraments but will need time to orient himself as well to a new home.

Because of Fr. Paul's arrival we will be able to return to our original Mass schedule that was approved by Bishop Fabbro last July. This will begin the week of February 6th.
