January 29, 2023 - 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The "Beatitudes" given to us by the Lord are to be a way of life for us - a measuring stick for our attitudes and actions - do they conform to Christ? Jesus taught from the Mountain, the figure of the New Moses - the New Lawgiver - or rather the perfecter of the Old Law in the New.

"Blessed" - more than "lucky", stronger than "fortunate". "Blessed"- those conformed to the will of the Father. The poor in spirit - they are "poor" in their self-reliance, thinking they can do it on their own. The poor in spirit have absolute trust in Jesus. Childlike confidence, utterly dependent - "poor" for Jesus.

"....Those who mourn"-not just the tribulations that populate our lives, or the sorrow of those who mourn the dead, but those who sorrow for sin, those that see what sin and injustice do to them, to others, and to the world.

"....The meek"- those who imitate the meekness of Christ.

"....Those who hunger and thirst for righteousness"- not this world's sense of "righteousness or correctness"- but God's righteousness. Not those who loot and riot in the false name of "justice" but those who long for the dignity of the unborn, the elderly, the defenseless, the marginalized. Those who long for the dignity of the human person to be upheld and protected.

"....The merciful" - those who have had a profound experience of God's mercy towards them can become instruments of mercy to others. "True mercy" is not the watering down of Sacred Scripture or Church teaching but the merciful application of divine wisdom. To be merciful we must first acknowledge that WE are in need of mercy. We then seek that mercy, receive that mercy, then give that mercy.

"....Pure in heart" - there are no "idols" in our hearts - God is first in our lives. What competes in our lives for God's primacy? A longing for power or money, prestige?

"....Persecuted for righteousness' sake"-You are "Blessed" if someone has made fun of you because you go to Mass, that you pray, that you live your life to the beat of another drummer - Jesus Christ.

".... reviled, persecuted, false accounts, gossip" - Jesus was subjected to abuse. He was reviled, persecuted, the subject of gossip, and drunkards' songs at the gates. As the master has gone, so the sheep must follow. He will give us the strength to endure and triumph - but it is the lot of the Baptized - pick up your cross daily and follow me.

When you have experienced or struggled with all of this"rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven".
