Hospitality and putting God first go hand-in-hand. We are called to put God first in our lives which means that we have a relationship with God that draws us to put God first. If we love someone with all our mind, heart, and soul, we will want to naturally put them first.

Elisha received great hospitality from the wealthy woman of Shunem. She recognized the fact that Elisha was a "holy man of God" and even built him a "granny suite" on her house for him to stay. But she had a problem, no child. In return for her hospitality God blessed her through Elisha "you shall embrace a son". Her hospitality was rewarded – "what so ever you do to the least of these your brothers and sisters you do unto me..."

God is the source of all love; God is our primary love relationship. From that relationship all other relationships flow.
