June 11, 2023 - Corpus Christ Sunday

Dear friends,

I have always been struck by a comment made regarding the Eucharist by J.R. Tolkien, the Catholic author well known for his book, *The Lord of the Rings*. Writing to his son, on one occasion, Tolkien remarked: "Out of the darkness of my life, so much frustrated, I put before you the one thing to love on earth: the Blessed Sacrament ... There you will find romance, glory, honor, fidelity, and the true way of all your loves on earth ... which every man's heart desires".

You notice Tolkien didn't say his works of literature were his greatest gift to his son, but the Eucharistic faith that he had led him to.

So, too, we treasure the Eucharist, the summit of our Catholic faith. The sacrifice and meal of the Mass is given to us daily. Jesus longs for communion – "common – union" with us. Do we long for Him? Hopefully during the experience of the pandemic when we were deprived for the common good from congregating together gave us a taste of what it is to long for the Lord" in His Body and Blood.

As we eat His flesh and drink His blood we are renewed, our bodies put on future incorruptibility as **we** share in His resurrection on the last day. The Eucharist is the remedy, the healing of our sin. Jesus, as the divine physician gives himself to us as a "spiritual medicine". The Eucharist is for sinners, is for us. We acknowledge our sins at the beginning of every Mass so that we may go with confidence to the Eucharistic table. The Sacrament of reconciliation is provided for us where Jesus waits as divine physician to pour his healing balm on our wounded souls and fill us with his grace to go out again into the world.

The Eucharist simply put is our treasure – it is Jesus!
