**MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR, FATHER CHRISTOPHER
THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY, JUNE 15, 2025**

Today I want to thank our beautiful musicians and choir for the wonderful mass with our Bishop two weekends ago for the enshrinement of St. Justin Martyr – it was beautiful! There was much work and effort put into that celebration (lectors, servers, decorators, AV people, Dan for his coordination – Tanya for her gifts) and the lunch at the Marconi Club was good as usual. I thought for next year we might simply have a Family BBQ for our Annual FOP luncheon – what do you think? Maybe at St. Leopold's because of their beautiful grounds – maybe a soccer game too?

Today we celebrate the God who reaches out to us and calls us by grace to enter into the mystery of his being.

In Proverbs, we can hear or imagine the Holy Spirit speaking the Words, “When he marked out the foundations of the earth, then I was beside him, like a master worker; and I was daily his delight...” Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – co-eternal. The psalmist in Psalm 8 speaks of the immanence of God as God creates – “your heavens, the work of your fingers...”

(The Holy Spirit), “he will guide you into all the truth.” We celebrate the mystery of the Trinity not in an attempt to solve a puzzle or figure out a mystery. You don't enter a relationship with another person to solve the mystery of who they are, but rather to enter the mystery daily – self-revelation in love is not done in a day but over a lifetime. You know when I hear some say (or even myself think at times) prayer can be “a chore” – something I know that is good for me, but I don't “feel” like doing it now. That is our imperfect but very human response. God on the other hand is “all in” for a deep relationship with us. God is passionately in love with us. God is constantly revealing himself to us. The fullest revelation of God is Jesus Christ, but that doesn't mean that God does not speak to us in nature, through others – even those we live with! Silence is the playing field for our relationship with God. We need deep silence in our lives and for our prayer. God is the master of the encounter, let God direct your prayer – ask the Holy Spirit the Master Spiritual director to guide you.

God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is waiting on us to respond to the Trinity's grace.
