MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR, FATHER CHRISTOPHER  
CORPUS CHRISTI - SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST  
- JUNE 22, 2025

Dear friends,

It is hard to believe that summer is upon us – I believe we have all earned it. Today we celebrate a central mystery, a central gift of the Lord – the gift of his very body and blood. Because we are gifted by the Eucharist, we need a special day to remind ourselves of the “awesomeness” of this reality.

What a privilege it is to have “communion” with the Lord each Sunday. Our God who loves to reveal himself to us, gives himself in His Body and Blood for our nourishment. It is in the Eucharist, in eating his flesh and drinking his blood that Christ “divinizes” us. We put on imperishability – the Eucharist makes it possible for our bodies to rise from the dead. Christ truly is our viaticum, our food for the journey. Not only at the hour of our death but for all the hours of our life. In adoring the sacrament at Holy Hour or privately we are saturated by His graces. As the old man said to St. Jean Vianney – who one day saw him simply sitting at the back of the Church, “What are you doing?” said the Curé. The old man replied, “I am looking at Him and He is looking at me.” That is an intense awareness of communion with God – the simple gaze.

As a reminder (as it was announced last week at the 4:30pm Mass at St. Francis-St. Martin’s), the 4:30 p.m. Mass (at St. Francis-St. Martin’s) will be discontinued as of June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025. We have monitored it for the last three years – the numbers cannot justify its continuing.

Also, we have noticed at St. Justin’s that our candle sales intake has been less than the actual candles being lit, i.e. – people are lighting the candles and not paying. This has become an expensive problem. So, to remedy this – candles will be sold at the Welcome Desk before and after Mass and then you will take the candle to the shrine and light it there. Thank you for your cooperation.
