We celebrated the Funeral Mass for "Clyde" Glasgow this past Friday. We celebrate his years of service to St. Justin's parish, and we pray for the repose of his soul and the comforting of his family.

What role does fear play in your life? Fear can be a debilitating disease in our lives. Fear can keep us from living out our lives in the freedom that God wishes us to experience. Fear can keep us from talking about our faith - keep us from witnessing, from being a disciple.

Jeremiah in our first reading has plenty he could be afraid about; terrors, rumours, people trying to take his life. Yet he turns to the Lord, "sing to the Lord; praise the Lord! For he has delivered the life of the needy..." He recalls what God has done in the past and what he promises for the future.

Jesus in our Gospel today reminds us "Fear no one...." Are not two sparrows sold for a penny?
