## June 4, 2023 - Most Holy Trinity Sunday

Dear friends,

I would like to congratulate all who have begun to receive their 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion at St. Leopold's, St. Francis-St. Martin's, and St. Justin's. What a beautiful reminder to all of us of the centrality of the Eucharist and the importance of regular reception of the Bread of Life.

We have ended the joyous season of Easter now with the great feast of Pentecost. For this week and next we go back to basics as it were. We are presented today with the mystery of God in totality – the Most Holy Trinity. This feast reminds us of the desire of God, the “work” of God to self-reveal. Perfect love leads to revelation. God reveals as Father creator, Son redeemer, Holy Spirit sanctifier. The mystery of the Trinity is not something to be solved but something to be entered into. Just as we enjoy a good mystery novel – we don't go to the end as we begin to read the book. We slowly go from chapter to chapter growing further and further into the mystery. Eternity will be comprised of a loving journey, an accompaniment with God into the mystery of who God is.

St. Augustine described the Trinity as the Lover, the Beloved, and Love Himself:

1. The Father (The Lover) loves the Son (The Beloved).
2. The Son returns the love of the Father.
3. The Spirit is the bond of love between the Father and Son.

In his book, “Mere Christianity”, C. S. Lewis wrote: “The union between the Father and the Son is such a live concrete thing that this union itself is also a Person. What grows out of the joint life of the Father is a real Person, in fact the Third of the three Persons who are God.” The relationship between the three persons is so close that they “indwell” on one another, and all share in the distinct work of each. Their mutual indwelling activity has been traditionally described as a kind of “Dance.” The key to understanding the Trinity is to recognize that it is not just a math problem (how can three be one?), the Trinity is a relationship.”

I hope you will all join together for our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Family of Parishes Luncheon held this year at St Leopold Mandic. There are a few tickets available after the Masses.

### Just a Friendly Reminder

"If you wish to receive the Precious Blood of the Lord, you **MUST** consume it from the chalice provided in front of the priest /deacon / eucharistic minister. You *may not* take the Body of the Lord and dip it into the chalice. This is called intinction. There is too much of a danger that the precious blood will drop off the host and onto the floor, and also, you cannot give yourself communion. Please refrain from doing this. Please realize that whether you receive under the form of bread or wine, you are receiving the Lord in His totality. The choice is yours."
